**San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report**

Clara Rieder, Public Health Preparedness Manager, reported **No New Cases today. San Patricio County's COVID-19 case count is 11 with 97 tests conducted.** The immediate risk of transmission in the County remains minimal.

Currently, San Patricio County does not have any individuals with COVID-19 whose symptoms require hospitalization. Further, a total of four (4) individuals have recovered and were released from the COVID-19 protocol.
