## San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report

Public Health Preparedness Manager Clara Rieder reported **one** (1) **new case today** that is under investigation. **The County's active case count moves up to twenty-two** (22) and there is no change to **Recovered total of 37**. The County's **confirmed COVID-19 case count is now 59** and our completed tests count is 758. The immediate risk of transmission in the County is minimal.
