**San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report**

Public Health Preparedness Manager Clara Rieder reported that **three (3) county employees** received confirmed positive tests for COVID-19 and are among the County's **confirmed COVID-19 case count that is now 96**. Today we added **eleven (11) new cases**. All but one of these cases are under investigation. The **County's active case count moves up to forty-seven (47)**. The County's completed tests count is 841. **The immediate risk of transmission in the County moves from minimal up to low.**
