**San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report**

Public Health Preparedness Department reported **thirteen (13) new cases today** that are all under investigation and our hospitalizations count remains at one (1). The **County's confirmed COVID-19 case count will move to 352**. The County's active case count moves down to **144** as this count also denotes that **thirty (30) individuals were released from COVID-19 protocol**. The County's completed tests count is 1687. The County's immediate risk of transmission is intermediate.
