San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report

Public Health Preparedness Department reported **fifty-two (52) new cases today** that are all under investigation and our hospitalizations count stays at two (2). The **County's confirmed COVID-19 case count will move to 492**. The County's active case count moves up to **224** as this count also denotes that **fifteen (15) individuals were released from COVID-19 protocol**. The County's completed tests count is 1960. The County's immediate risk of transmission is intermediate.
