San Patricio County's COVID-19 Situation Report

San Patricio County Public Health Department (SPCPHD) has been approved as a COVID-19 vaccine provider. We want to thank JM Lozano's Office for reaching out to the Texas Department of State Health Services. As a provider, SPCPHD will now be eligible to receive COVID-19 vaccine allocations in the future.

Although vaccine hubs aim to provide more vaccines quicker and easier, Texas vaccine supply is limited (with more arriving every week) and it will take time to vaccinate all.
