The registration for the First Dose Moderna Vaccine Clinic closed after booking 700 appointments. This Clinic will take place on Tuesday and Wednesday next week at the Event Center located at the County Fairgrounds. **This afternoon, individuals who received a vaccine appointment received an appointment confirmation via email or Robocall.**
